Entries for individual events are limited to three entries per gender per school. Entries for relay events are limited to two entries per gender per school. Entries shall not be permitted past the entry deadline. Scratches and entry replacements for individual events shall be made immediately following the swim coaches meeting and no later than 10:00am. Competitors may not be pulled from an event to compete as an entry replacement. Event entry adjustments will not result in reseeding an event; heat and lane assignments will remain as originally seeded and assigned.

Relay team member adjustments made by 9:45am on the day of meet shall be made directly to the meet management software operator by the head coach. Adjustments after 9:45am on the day of meet shall be reported by the head coach to the meet referee. Upon approval by the meet referee, adjustments shall be reported by the head coach to both the meet management software operator and timers at assigned lane.

Schedule to declare relay team members including the lead-off swimmer shall be as follows:

200 Medley Relay Declare relay team members by 10:00am

200 Yard Freestyle Relay

Declare relay team members by start of 100 Yard Butterfly

400 Yard Freestyle Relay

Declare relay team members by start of 200 Yard Freestyle Relay

Divers will perform eleven dives. Diving scoresheets are due to the diving referee one hour prior to the start of diving competition; failure to submit by the deadline will result in the diver not being eligible to compete in diving competition. Changes to diving scoresheets are permitted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of diving competition. Four copies of diving scoresheets for each diver must be provided by the dive coach.

A meet program will be emailed to coaches the Friday before each scheduled meet.

Event Information

Each school is responsible for providing one adult volunteer timer. Volunteer timers must check in at the control room by 10:00am.

Order of events shall be as follows:

200 vd/m medley relay 200 yd/m freestyle 200 yd/m individual medley 50 yd/m freestyle diving* 1m 100 yd/m butterfly 100 yd/m freestyle 500 yd/400 m freestyle 200 yd/m freestyle relay 100 yd/m backstroke 100 yd/m breaststroke 400 yd/m freestyle relay



*Diving competition is hosted independently from swimming competition; refer to event schedule.

There will be a 5 minute break after the 200 yd/m medley relay, a 10 minute break after the 50 yd/m freestyle and a 5 minute break after the 200 yd/m freestyle relay.

An automatic timing system will be used for timing races. Points will be awarded as follows:

Individual: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 Relays: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

Team championship ties are resolved in the following order:

- 1. The team with the greatest number of 1st place finishers in individual events shall be declared the team champion.
- 2. The team with the greatest number of 1st place finishers in relay events shall be declared the team champion.
- 3. Points earned from a team's highest scoring relay team for each relay event will be compiled; the team with the highest composite score shall be declared the team champion.
- 4. If a tie still exists, a coin flip among the tied teams shall determine the team champion.

The event director will coordinate event site responsibilities with the meet director and other appropriate event personnel.

Awards

Albuquerque Metro Championship apparel, individual championship medals and the team championship trophy will be presented at the conclusion of the meet.
